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# INTRODUCTION

### What is Hidden Treasure Quest?

Hidden Treasure Quest is a Christian discipleship series for ages 9 to 14. The books are designed to guide readers in developing their **own** relationship with the Lord while learning how to apply God's Word to their lives and follow Jesus Christ. The books can be read independently or as a group. This Guide will discuss group reading with a teacher/leader.

### How are the lessons in this Guide structured?

Each chapter in the book has been divided into two lessons.

- The first lesson for each chapter:
  - Read the chapter to the students.
  - Complete the *Review Questions* found in the Study Guide.
- The second lesson for each chapter:
  - Complete the *Bible Study Questions* in the Study Guide.
  - Complete the *Activity Page* in the Study Guide.

All lessons will also involve memorizing selected Bible verses, prayer, oral review and open discussion. In addition, Bible reading assignments are sent with each student to complete at home. (A list of all Memory Verses and Assigned Bible Reading are included in this Guide.). If desired, teachers can keep track of students who read the assignments and memorize verses using the charts on pages 27 and 28.

### How are the Study Guide questions designed?

For each chapter, the Study Guide (a separate book) includes three or more pages of questions and activities.

<u>Review Questions</u>: These questions will help readers review what they read in each chapter of the *Hidden Treasure Quest* book.

<u>Bible Study Questions</u>: These questions require additional study and readers usually need to use their Bible to find the answers. Some of these questions are more challenging and may require additional help depending on the age of the reader.

<u>Chapter Activities</u>: These activities are a fun way to reinforce the topics found in each chapter. Instructions are provided with each activity. *These activities can be completed in either lesson for the chapter as time permits.* 

### What materials will you need?

To complete the questions and activities in the lessons, teachers will need the book titled *Hidden Treasure Quest: Knowing God Through Creation*, the matching Study Guide, a Bible, a dictionary, and the pages found in this Teacher's Guide. (You will need to make copies of some pages.)

### **Useful Tips**

- There are a few options for teaching a group of students.
  - 1. Buy one book and one Study Guide for the teacher only. The teacher will read the book to the group and make copies of the Study Guide pages for each child.
  - 2. Buy one book for the teacher only. Buy the Study Guide for the teacher and each child. The teacher reads the book to the group and each child has their own Study Guide.
  - 3. Buy books for the teacher and students. Buy only one Study Guide for the teacher to make copies.
  - 4. The teacher *and* all students have both the book and Study Guide. (This method is recommended. Since loose, copied worksheets often get thrown away, we

recommend that each child have their own book and Study Guide. This will allow them to refer to the books even when the class is complete. Discipleship is a life-long process and should be encouraged at home in addition to church. Having their own books will encourage at-home study.)

- Bible journaling is optional but is recommended and is explained on pages 17 and 18.
   When Assigned Bible Readings are given, Bible journaling should be completed every time students read the Bible.
- It is recommended to make copies of the Memory Verses (pages 19-23) and Assigned Bible Reading List (pages 24-26) for each student so they can remember what to read. Encourage students to keep the lists in the their Bible Journal Notebook and bring the notebook to class each week (along with their books if they have them).
- Students do not have to read the entire Bible reading assignment in one sitting but should complete it before the next lesson. (They can read one checkbox at a time.) Each time a student reads part of their assignment, they should write in their Bible journal.
- The lessons can be started at any time of year. The books do not include lessons for holidays. If you desire, you will need to insert your own lessons for holidays such as Easter or Christmas.
- Since the lessons build on each other and involve reading continuously through a book, it is best for the same teacher to be present for all lessons.
- If a chapter brings about a lot of questions or discussion or you are short on time, reading a chapter can be divided into more than one lesson. (This approach will work best when the same teacher is always present.)
- As an option, teachers may use the Bible Reading Chart (pages 27-28) to keep track of who has read the assigned Bible reading at home each week and memorized their memory verses. [The bonus memory verses (on pages 19-23) may be memorized at home.] Teachers can ask students to bring their lists each week to class and use the Bible Reading Chart to check off which students did their assigned reading. Students who complete all assignments get a prize when all lessons are complete.
- For the curriculum to last 9 months, the lessons should be taught once per week according
  to the Suggested Lesson Plan (pages 8-16). The time for this class may be extended if
  more than two lessons are needed for a chapter and/or if additional lessons are inserted
  for holidays.
- During lessons, encourage questions and open discussion. There are no bad questions. Help students feel comfortable asking questions, even if their question expresses doubt.
- Always leave time for prayer during the lesson.

### **BIBLE JOURNALING**

When we say "Bible Journaling" we do not mean coloring pictures in your Bible as some journaling involves. Keeping a Bible Journal while reading *Hidden Treasure Quest* is optional but encouraged. It is a great way to help students spend time meditating on God's Word and learning how to apply it to their lives. The practice of journaling during this study will hopefully help students develop skills that they will continue to use when they are finished reading the *Hidden Treasure Quest* book.

### What is Bible Journaling?

Every time students read in their Bible at home they should write in their Bible journal (a simple notebook). We recommend using the SOAP method.

Write the verses you read and the date at the top of the paper. Spell the word SOAP vertically on the side of your paper.

- **S** = **Scripture.** Pick at least one verse you read during your Bible reading and write it down next to the letter "S".
- **O = Observation.** What did this verse mean in your own words? Write a few sentences next to the letter "O"
- **A = Application.** How can you take the meaning of this scripture and apply it to your own life? Write a few sentences next to the letter "A".
- **P = Prayer.** Write down a quick prayer about what you have read. Write your prayer next to the letter "P"

You may need to help younger students remember the words "Observation" and "Application" until they get used to the process. Tell students to write down the SOAP acronym (and the meaning of each letter) on the inside cover of their journal so they can remember the process.

Journaling can be done in a simple, inexpensive notebook that you would find in your local retail store. See the following page for an example entry. (You can make a copy of this example for each student, if desired.)

### Mark 1 and Mark 2

- P Lord, thank you that you have amazing plans for my life! Help me to not only read your Word but do what it says. Thank you that, because of my faith in you, I have nothing to fear or worry about.
